Course Alignment

Notes:

1. Students must be enrolled in at least four periods at their high school before taking college courses for dual credit.
2. Students may apply up to 50 credits of pre-approved college/university courses toward high school graduation.
3. In general, except where noted, PCC (or other college) semester courses for 4 or 5 units are credited with a full year (10 credits) of high school credit. PCC (or other college) semester courses for 2 or 3 units are credited with one semester (5 credits) of high school credit. College courses for 1 unit are given 0 dual credit for high school.
4. In general, only those PCC (or other college) 100-level courses are weighted *if* the aligned high school course is weighted.
5. Many colleges and universities recalculate GPA during the admission process and give weighted credit for college courses at that time.
